All are represented on the Transport and Logistics Certification Council, which oversees the management of the CPL program, and the companion Certified Transport Planner program.

Each recommendation for accreditation as a CPL goes to the Council for endorsement.

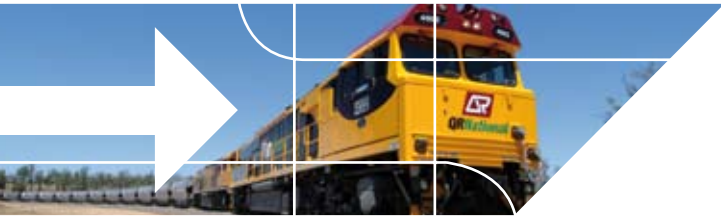

## Certified Professional Logician (CPL)

Australia's growing transport and logistics task, and the increasing sophistication of logistics and related supply chain management, provides a wide range of exciting career opportunities.

Professionalism of a high order is required to manage the collection, transport, warehousing and distribution of freight in a seamless and integrated supply chain framework.

## The CPL Program

The Certified Professional Logician program recognises professionals who have already made a significant contribution in logistics and supply chain management, and who are committed to further development of their capabilities.

Holding CPL accreditation indicates that you have significant expertise and engagement in logistics and supply chain management. You are able to marshal effectively the technology and leadership skills required to handle complex issues in moving freight and coordinating with the related information flows and business relationships.

## Continuing Professional Development

An important feature of the CPL is the requirement to undertake continuing professional development to maintain your accreditation.

Your professional development can include activity such as formal education or training, informal learning opportunities, conference or seminar attendance, and involvement in association events and management.

The commitment to continuing professional development by certificate holders is a significant advantage to their employers as it underpins currency of skills and knowledge.

## A Career Partner

CPL accreditation supports your career by confirming that you have received independent assessment of professional capability. Employers can be confident that you have met a recognised industry benchmark.

As a CPL you will be asked to agree to abide by a code of professional conduct. This code will guide your ongoing contribution to logistics and supply chain management.

On achieving CPL status, you will join many other professionals in the freight and logistics industry, supply chain management and Defence logistics.



## Becoming a CPL

The first step to becoming a CPL is to apply through the program website at [www.cplinstitute.com](http://www.cplinstitute.com).

As well as providing further information on the CPL program, the website has a Points Calculator. Using the Calculator, you can make an initial check of your eligibility against the threshold of 400 points of combined work experience, education, training, and professional involvement.

Having achieved that threshold, you can then choose one of the participating organisations to assess your application. That organisation will be in touch with you about the detailed requirements for assessment.

There is a fee of \$500 for the initial assessment and accreditation stage, and thereafter an annual renewal fee of \$75 to cover review of professional development undertaken in the preceding twelve months. This is required for you to retain use of the 'CPL' post-nominal.
